Notes from the HOA

The Board of Directors would like to thank members that attended the 2009 Annual Meeting. It was a long meeting with much to discuss and we appreciate the valuable input received. We would like to take this opportunity to update members on some of the actions items raised at the meeting.

The vote of the membership was in favor of keeping the wall and restoring it to its original appearance. The Board have approved the quote from Sealmark, pending agreement of terms. The quote included the wall and the resurfacing of all of the signs within Laurel Oak Ranch (excluding the new sign at West-over). Work is due to start at the end of July and will take approx 6-8 weeks to complete. Much work will take place in preparation of the renovation; the lettering on all signs will be removed and re-vamped, bushes must be trimmed away from the wall and access gained from each side. The use of solar panels is being explored to provide light to the signs. We look forward to seeing the amazing results of this community project by September.

In response to the memberships concern regarding speeding cars the board are investigating the following deterrents; more speed signs, speed bumps and three way stop signs. Any one of these options must be first approved by the City of High Point.

Also in response to membership feedback, the Board is obtaining quotes to enhance the areas currently seeded with love grass in the Village

section of the community. Due to the size of the area concerned any approved action will be done in sections.

The playground area has been subjected to acts of vandalism and trespassing. In light of this and the cost associated with correcting such acts the Board is considering options including the use of surveillance cameras. Please call the police if you see any suspicious activity or trespassing after dark and please remember to keep your pets out of the fenced in area as we want to maintain a safe and clean environment for the community's children.

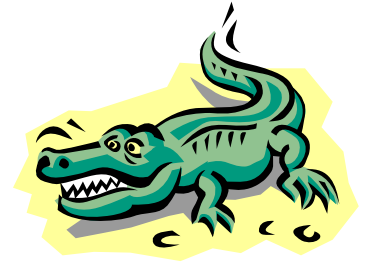

Swimmers take your mark! Set, go Gators! The Gators had their first meet on June 23rd. Everyone did a great job and we are proud of all of the swimmers.

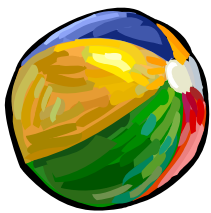

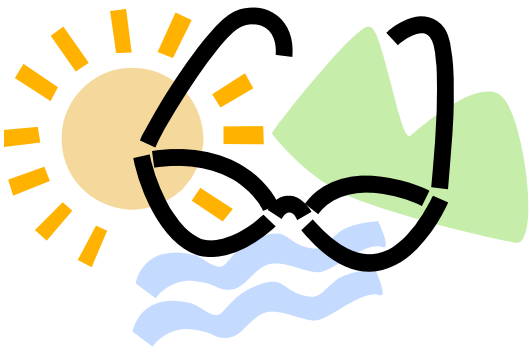
