Speeding within Laurel Oak Ranch

The Board of Directors, in response to homeowner concerns, are actively working with the City of High Point to reduce speeding through the community.

The Board met with City Councilman, Latimer Alexander on 09/21/09. Mr. Alexander discussed the options available to Laurel Oak Ranch to reduce the average speed of vehicles within the main 'collector streets'; Old Plank Road, Election Oak Drive and Evans Mill Road. Details of the cost, effectiveness and aesthetics of each option are being researched by the City and will be presented to the Board to discuss at the next Board meeting. The research and discussion period will be several months;

further details will be included in the next newsletter.

We ask that members of the community and their guests be mindful of the 25mph speed limit to ensure the safety of other motorists and pedestrians.

Wall and Sign Project

The wall and sign project is well underway but due to weather restrictions and the extent of the repairs needed, the project time has been extended. It is anticipated that the entrance wall and community signs will be complete, including new lettering, by mid October. We are excited about the transformation and the positive impact it will have on the aesthetics of the community.

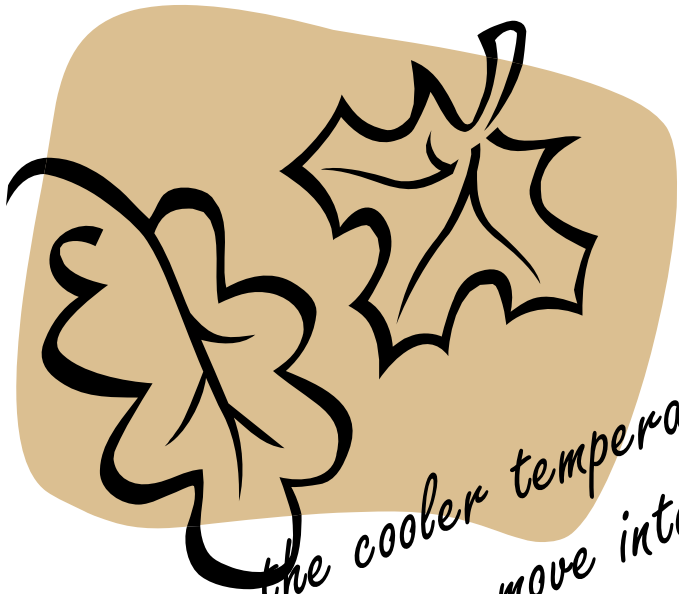
